2 on 2 Audio Board Manual

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Removal & Installation Instructions

- 1. Power down the audio system by unplugging the power from the wall source.
- 2. Remove all Molex plugs from the back of the console and open the case.
- 3. Disconnect the button panel ribbon connector and all components from the board.
- 4. Remove the #4-40 nuts from the board.
- 5. Remove the heat sink from the back case (if needed).
- 6. Remove the board.
- 7. Making sure that the standoffs are still on the studs, install the new board (Note: the heat sink is now located on the board and does not need to be remounted to the case).
- 8. Attach the board with (3) of the #4-40 nuts removed in step 4 and the (2) 5/8" long hex standoffs provided in this kit. (Note: the standoffs go into the (2) corners at the button board end.)
- 9. Re-connect all components and button board ribbon connector.
- 10. Re-connect all Molex plugs into the back of the console and close the case making sure not to pinch any of the wires.
- 11. Power up the unit and test.
- 12. Adjust audio pots for desired audio levels.
