

Phillips Screwdriver
Drill Motor
Caulking Gun
5/16" Wrench or Nut Driver

Installation Procedure

- 1. With the drawer closed, remove the customer microphone being careful to not lose the harness connector back into the window frame.
- 2. Place the Drip Flange over the microphone hole with the gutter flange to the bottom and temporarily reinstall the microphone and wiring.
- 3. Align the bottom edge of the Drip Flange so it has and even gap all across the top of the Customer Door. (NOTE: There needs to be a gap between the bottom of the Drip Flange and the top of the Customer Door or the flange will not allow the drawer to fully close.)
- 4. Mark the center of the outer holes in the Drip Flange.
- 5. Drill at these marks with the #29 drill bit provided.
- 6. Thread these holes with the #8-32 tap provided.
- 7. Remove the microphone and Drip Flange and clean off any dirt and debris from the window frame and flange.
- 8. Apply a thin continuous bead of caulking to the back of the Drip Flange so that the bead runs above the microphone and mounting holes.
- 9. Loosely install Drip Flange with the outer screws, then connect microphone and reinstall.
- 10. Check the alignment and gap between flange and Customer Door.
- 11. Tighten all mounting screws.
- 12. Apply a small amount of caulk to fill the gaps between the bottom of the microphone housing and the clearance hole in the bottom of the gutter flange.
- 13. Clean off any excess caulk at the microphone and around the edges.
- 14. Test Drawer and Audio for proper operation.
