#### **Tools Needed**

Philips Screwdriver 5/16" Nutdriver or Wrench

#### For an Unprepared Skin, also have:

Ruler or Tape Measure
Center Punch
Electric Drill
3/16" Drill Bit
7/8" Diameter Drill or Uni-bit or Knock-out Punch
11/32" Nutdriver or Wrench

### **Attaching Handset Assembly to a Prepared Skin**

(The following should be completed before the skin and top cap are installed onto the customer unit.)

- 1. Remove tape covering the wiring hole.
- 2. Remove the acorn nut and the Keps nut from the studs on the skin. (The acorn nuts are there only for protection during shipment.)
- 3. Attach the handset mounting bracket to the skin using a washer and a Keps nut. Make sure the wiring hole in the skin is aligned with the wiring hole in the bracket.
- 4. Install the 7/8" snap in bushing into this hole and route the wires through it.
- 5. Connect the cables together making sure the numbers correspond.
- 6. At this point you may want to check the volume pot setting. Adjusting this pot will change the volume of the handset's speaker.
- 7. Mount the cover housing to the bracket using the three 8-32 x 3/8" button socket cap screws provided.
- 8. Install the skin assembly.

#### **Attaching Handset Assembly to an Unprepared Skin**


(The following should be completed before the skin and top cap are installed onto the customer unit.)

- 1. Mark and drill holes as shown in Fig. 1. (Caution: Varying from the shown dimensions could cause interference with internal structure of the Customer unit and/or top cap during skin installation.)
- 2. Attach the handset mounting bracket to the skin using the 8-32 x 1/2" Philips truss head screws, 3/16" aluminum washers, and 8-32 nylon locking nuts provided.
- 3. Using the 9/64" hole that is centered on the bracket and 1" below the upper mounting holes as a template, drill a pilot hole through the skin. Then with drill, Uni-bit or Knock-out punch make a 7/8" hole through the bracket and skin. (Cover the volume pot on the bracket to protect it from metal chips.)
- 4. Install the 7/8" snap in bushing into this hole and route the wires through it.
- 5. Connect the cables together making sure the numbers correspond.
- 6. At this point you may want to check the volume pot setting. Adjusting this pot will change the volume of the handset's speaker.
- 7. Mount the cover housing to the bracket using the three 8-32 x 3/8" button socket cap screws provided.
- 8. Install the skin assembly.
